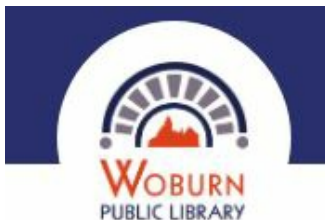

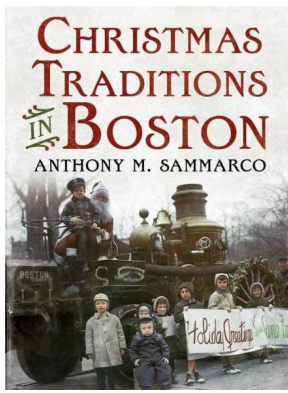

Smoking Law Reminder: In accordance with [Massachusetts Smoke-Free Workplace Law](#), smoking is prohibited at all times *anywhere* inside Cummings Properties' garages or buildings. By state law, all those wishing to smoke must do so outdoors and **at least 30 feet away** from any building entrance. This law also applies to the use of e-cigarettes, which are considered "nicotine delivery products" and are comparable to tobacco cigarettes. In addition, client firms with after-hours staff should remind employees that building entrance doors should *not* be propped open at any time, including for employees leaving the building for a "smoke break." 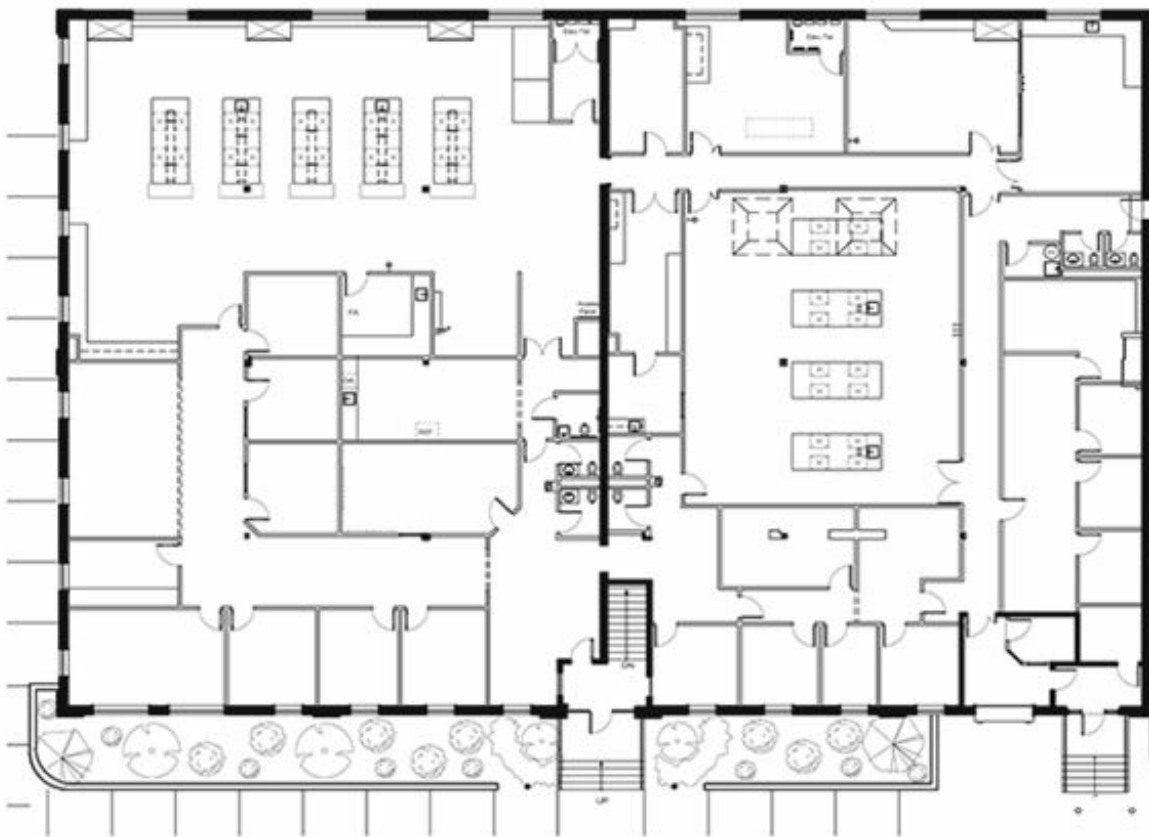
